

Ordinance No. -2020

An Ordinance approving and authorizing an application to the Cumberland County Roadway Department for the Millville Lightning Travel Baseball 10U to hold a coin drop on April 18, 2020 and April 19, 2020 at the intersections of Buckshutem Road and Cedarville Road; and

WHEREAS, the State Legislature amended N.J.S.A. 39:4-60 to allow charitable organizations to solicit contributions in the roadway of a County road provided that the charitable organization obtains authorization from the respective municipal governing body and further provided that charitable organization obtains the approval of the Cumberland County Board of Chosen Freeholders; and

WHEREAS, the Act further provides that a county shall not be civilly Liable for property damage or personal injury resulting from a motor vehicle accident arising out of or in the course of roadway solicitations for soliciting contributions conducted by charitable organizations; and

WHEREAS, an application for Roadway Charitable Solicitation Permit Application to the Cumberland County Board of Chosen Freeholders is necessary to ensure that safety considerations and traffic flow requirements are adequately addressed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF MILLVILLE:

(1) That the request from the Millville Lightning Travel Baseball 10U, to hold a coin drop on April 18, 2020 and April 19, 2020 at the intersections of Buckshutem Road and Cedarville Road is hereby approved pursuant to review and approval of the City of Millville Chief of Police and subject to final authorization by the Cumberland County Board of Chosen Freeholders; and

(2) That if at any time the coin drop starts to back traffic up onto Buckshutem Road or Cedarville Street beyond the normal amount of traffic congestion the coin drop may be shutdown until traffic begins to flow at a normal pace.

(3) Ultimate approval and jurisdiction is with the Cumberland County Board of Chosen Freeholders and all insurance requirements and other requirements rest with them and are subject to their approval.

ORDINANCE NO. -2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILLVILLE AMENDING CHAPTER 43 (“PARKS AND PUBLIC PROPERTY”) ARTICLE VII (“SPECIAL EVENTS ON PUBLIC LANDS”) SUBSECTION 43-36 (“DEFINITIONS”)

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the City of Millville, being duly elected by the people as their governing body are tasked with preparing local laws and ordinances; and

WHEREAS, from time to time the governing body shall undertake revisions so that these policies remain up to date (*N.J.S.A. 40:49-4*); and

WHEREAS, procedures for the Parks and Public Property Department are codified in Chapter 43 of the Millville City Code; and

WHEREAS, Millville Commission determines it in the best interest of the City and its citizens to revise Chapter 43. (“Parks and Public Property”) under Article VII (“Special Events on Public Lands”), Subsection 43-36 (“Definitions”) to revise permit requirements; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF MILLVILLE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1 – REVISION TO § 43-36:

In regard to § 43-36, under the definition of “Alcoholic Beverage Vendor’s Permit” the words *“A permit issued by the City Clerk to an applicant authorizing the sale of alcoholic beverages at a special event pursuant to these regulations. The applicant must possess a NJABC retail consumption license and either a NJABC catering permit or extension of premises permit for the subject premises and comply with all applicable regulations. A social affair permit for a nonprofit organization is not acceptable.”*, **shall be stricken from the code and replaced with:**

“A permit issued by the City Clerk to an applicant authorizing the sale of alcoholic beverages at a special event pursuant to these regulations. The applicant must possess a permit obtained with the New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control for Social Affairs, Catering or Extended Premises and approved by the Chief of Police and City Clerk.”

In regard to § 43-36, under the definition of “Distribution Area” the words *“An area clearly designated for the distribution or sale of alcoholic beverages.”*, **shall be stricken from the code and replaced with:**

“An area clearly designated for the distribution or sale of alcoholic beverages in accordance with New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control regulations.”

SECTION 2 - PARTIAL INVALIDITY:

Should any provision of this ordinance be deemed invalid for any reason that invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions of the ordinance, and the provisions and sections of the ordinance are hereby declared to be severable with respect to their validity.

SECTION 3 – INCONSISTENT ORDINANCE:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4 – EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after publication following final passage, according to law.
