**RESOLUTION APPROVING URBAN ENTERPRISE ZONE FUNDS TO SUPPORT COVID-19 RECOVERY**

WHEREAS, Governor Murphy signed Executive Order 103 on March 9, 2020 declaring a State of Emergency and a Public Health Emergency and subsequent orders including Stay at Home, mandatory business closures, and social distancing mandates, among others; and

WHEREAS, the City has developed a Covid-19 Response Pilot Program to reallocate certain funding and grant projects to an economic development program directed towards small business endurance and sustainable recovery planning; and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of dedicating up to \$25,000 of its UEZ revolving loan funds to support forgivable loans towards non-profit which serve as tourism and economic development centers for the community using the Covid-19 Nonprofit Recovery Program procedures.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Millville the use of UEZ funds to support the Covid-19 Nonprofit Recovery Program is hereby approved.
