### Annual Public Summary Report of Allegations and the Investigation concluded during a calendar year

In September 2011, the office of the Attorney General issued through the Division of Criminal Justice an updated version of Internal Affairs Policy and Procedures for all Law Enforcement Agencies in the State of New Jersey. Per requirement #10 of the Internal Affairs Policy and Procedures, the following is a report released to the public, summarizing the allegations received against members of the department and the investigation findings. In addition, the public must be notified of any internal discipline which resulted in a fine or suspension of a member of the department of ten (10) days or more.

#### Explanation of Findings:

Sustained:	The investigation disclosed sufficient evidence to prove the allegation and the actions of the officer violated a provision to the agency's rules and regulations or procedures.
Exonerated:	The alleged incident did occur, but the actions of the Officer were justified, legal and proper.
Not Sustained:	The investigation failed to disclose sufficient evidence to clearly prove or disprove the allegation.
Unfounded:	The alleged incident did not occur.
Administratively Closed:	The complaint was or investigation is closed prior to reaching a disposition. Examples include when a complainant voluntarily requests that a complaint be withdrawn, or the subject officer terminates his or her employment prior to disposition of the complaint.
