## ACUA SERVICES:

**Bulky Waste:** 2 items per trash day including household furniture. No construction waste, carpet, televisions or electronics.

**Latex Paint:** Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried latex paint can be disposed of in the trash. Oil based paint is considered hazardous waste, see CCIA's Services listed below for disposal information.

## MILLVILLE STREETS & ROADS SERVICES:

(Do not place these items curbside prior to 3 pm the day before your collection.)

**White Goods:** Streets & Roads will collect 2 metal items from the curb during the last full week of each month. Items include: appliances such as stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators etc.

**Tires:** Streets & Roads will collect 2 tires (rims removed) during the last full week of each month.

**Yard Waste:** Contact Streets & Roads for disposal schedule.

**Household Hazardous Waste & Electronics:** Neither are permitted for curbside collection. However, the following items may be dropped off Monday thru Friday from 7 am until 3 pm at 416 S 15th Street, Millville: **uncontaminated waste oil, uncontaminated anti-freeze, rechargeable batteries and electronic waste.**

## CUMBERLAND COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY

**Construction Waste:** Must be disposed of at CCIA's Solid Waste Complex.

**Household Hazardous Waste & Document Shredding Days:** April 10, June 12, and September 11 from 8 am until 2 pm at 169 Jesse Bridge Road, Rosenhayn (off Sherman Avenue, Route 552)

**Items accepted:** motor oil, car batteries, gasoline, fuel oil, oil based paints, stains, cleaning and garden chemicals, corrosives, antifreeze, propane tanks, fluorescent bulbs, rechargeable batteries, computers, monitors, laptops, dvd/cd players, printers, microwaves, phones, stereos, and televisions.
