GREEN MEANS GO!

Millville Recreation announced today, that Hankins Pond will get a chance to host ice skating at Corson Pond this winter if the temperature gets low enough and the ice gets thick enough.

Freezing temperatures and 4 inches of ice along with a green flag flying from the flagpole will be the requirements before Millville Recreation allows skating on the pond, located on E. Main St. This is the only "official" area allowed for skating within the City.

"We are keeping our fingers crossed that we will be able to get in several good days this winter for some ice skating which the entire family can enjoy" stated Mayor Tim Shannon. "Last year, we never got the conditions needed to get some skating in" stated Shannon.

Ice Skating is permitted under the following conditions:

- Permitted with a green flag flying, indicating safe conditions
- Red flag flying, no skating is permitted at all
- Skate within the barriers
- Children must be accompanied by an adult
- No motorized vehicles allowed on ice
- No skating after 10 pm to before 9 am
